Procedures and Requirements

From NFHS and SMAC guidelines:

- All directors and students should be screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 prior to a rehearsal. Screening includes a temperature check.
- Responses to screening questions for each person should be recorded and stored so that there is a record of everyone present in case a student develops COVID-19, with appropriate attention being given to privacy and confidentiality
- Any person with positive symptoms reported should not be allowed to take part in rehearsals and should contact his or her primary care provider or other appropriate health-care professional.
- Vulnerable individuals should not oversee or participate in any rehearsals.
- Individuals should wash their hands for a minimum of 20 seconds with warm water and soap before touching any surfaces or participating in rehearsals.
- Shared musical equipment should be wiped down thoroughly before and after an individual's use of equipment.
- All students shall bring their own water bottle. Water bottles must not be shared.
- Hydration stations (Coolers, water trough, water fountains, etc.) should not be utilized.

What does this mean for you?

It means you have to be more diligent and careful than you normally would be. We just do not know who has been exposed to what and we need to do our best to keep our environment clean and safe. We need to do this not just for us but for anyone we go home to that could be vulnerable.

YOU MUST

- Bring and wear a mask
- Bring a full water bottle and/or hydro flask and some extra bottled water.
- Not congregate in the storage rooms. Directors will tell you when to go into those areas.
- Clean and wipe down your equipment before and after rehearsal.
- Not empty spit valves onto the floor, we will have pads available.
- Maintain at least 6ft of distance from other students as much as possible.
- Stay in your assigned small groups and in your assigned areas.
- TAKE THIS SERIOUSLY.
